Mission Statement for Cincinnati's Complete Count Committee

Cincinnati's Complete Count Committee is a team of community and business leaders appointed by Mayor Mark Mallory to develop an outreach and awareness campaign for the 2010 Census.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The Committee's primary focus is to use every method and available resource to ensure that every city resident is counted in the 2010 Census in Cincinnati.

To accomplish this goal the Complete Count Committee will:

1. Create a network of support with local organizations to aid census count efforts.
2. Develop a timeline of activities for the Census campaign.
3. Build a relationship with the Office of Strategic Research for the State of Ohio to help Cincinnati with state assistance.
4. Create a relationship with the U.S. Census Bureau to encourage communication and cooperation.
5. Use the Social Compact DrillDown study to provide support and focus to the Census Bureau's count efforts in Cincinnati.
6. Organize a Public Awareness Campaign to educate Cincinnatians on the importance of the census.

Organization:

2. Charles Graves, Director of Planning Department, City of Cincinnati
